Graph 1: First question asked to the alumni members as part of feedback is about whether the curriculum is intellectually stimulating or not. 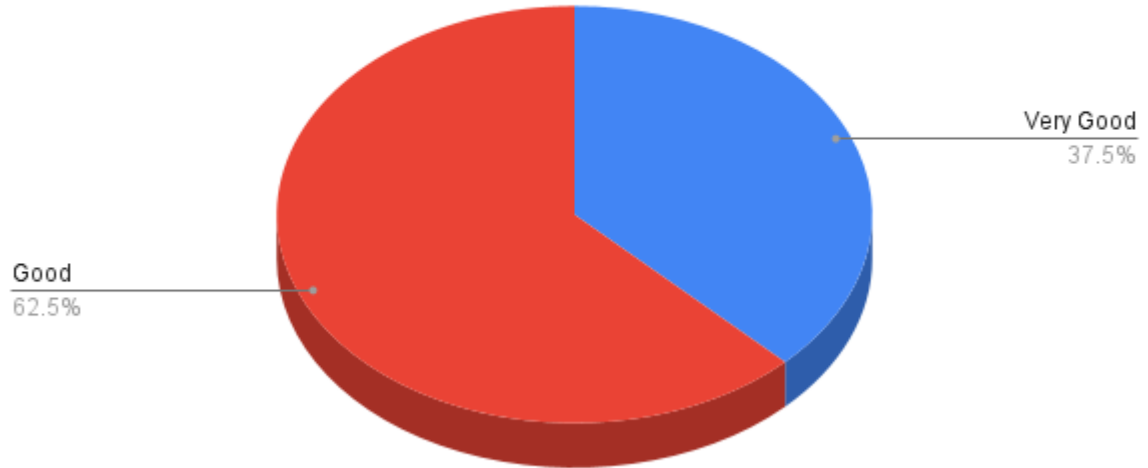

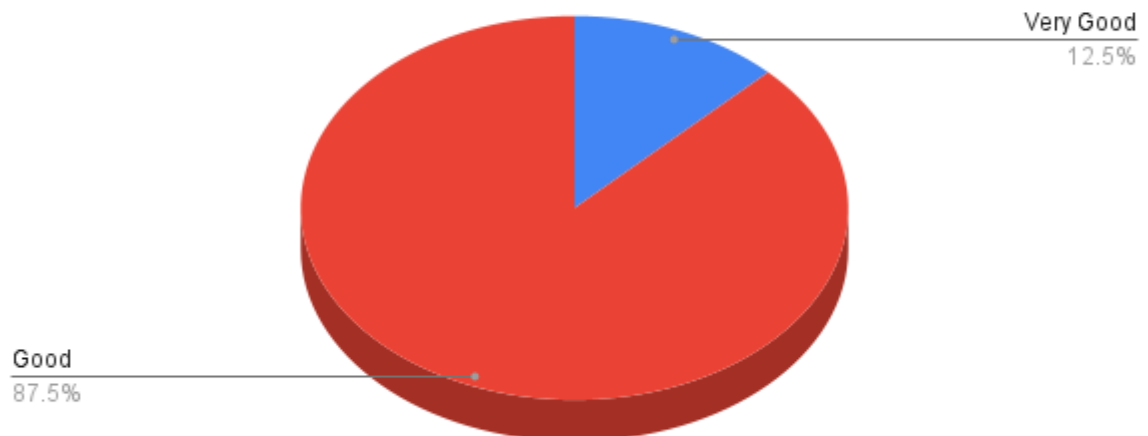

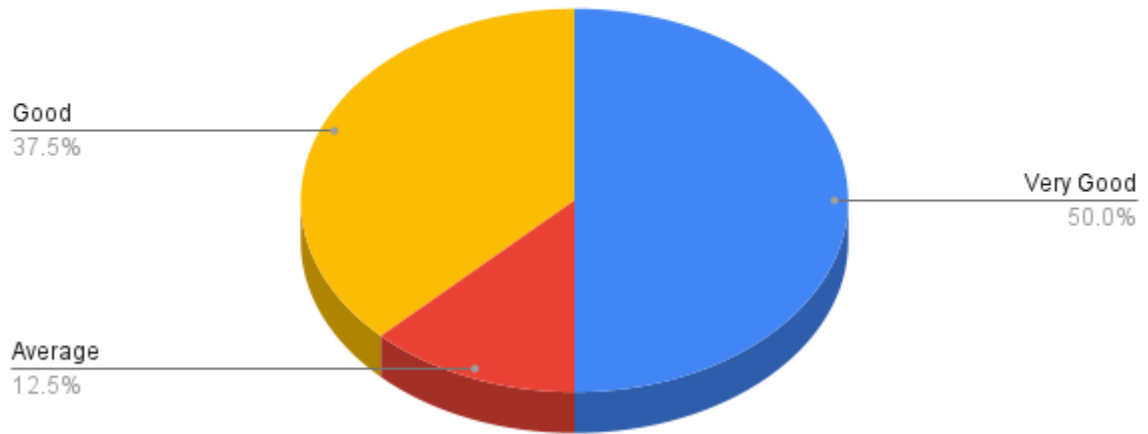


How do you rate the structure of syllabus prescribed for the programme?

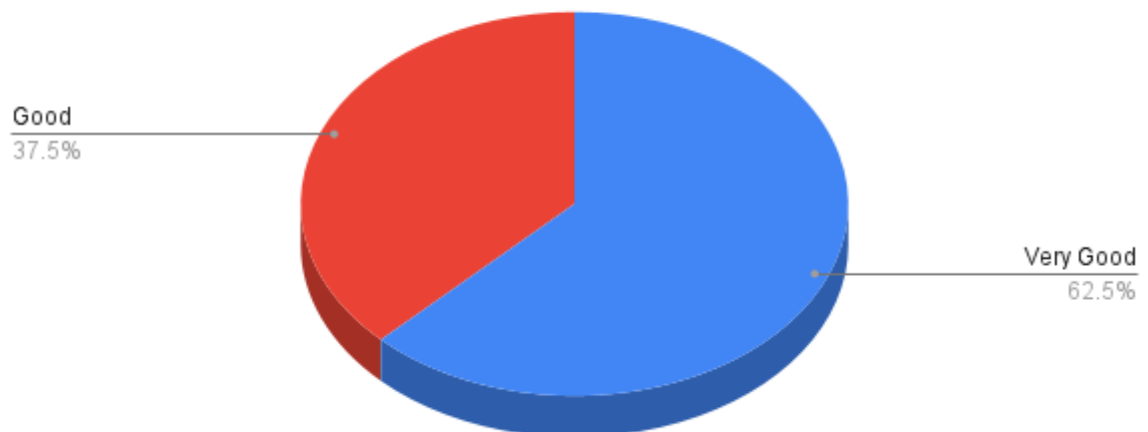




At what extent curriculum is updated enough or matched to current trends?

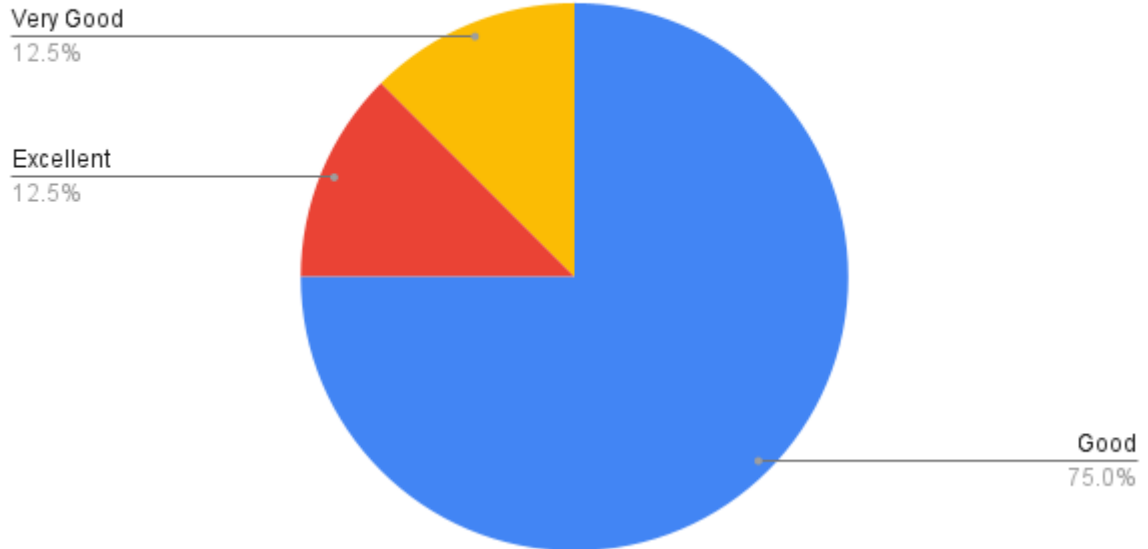


How do you rate the availability of materials and references regarding curriculum?

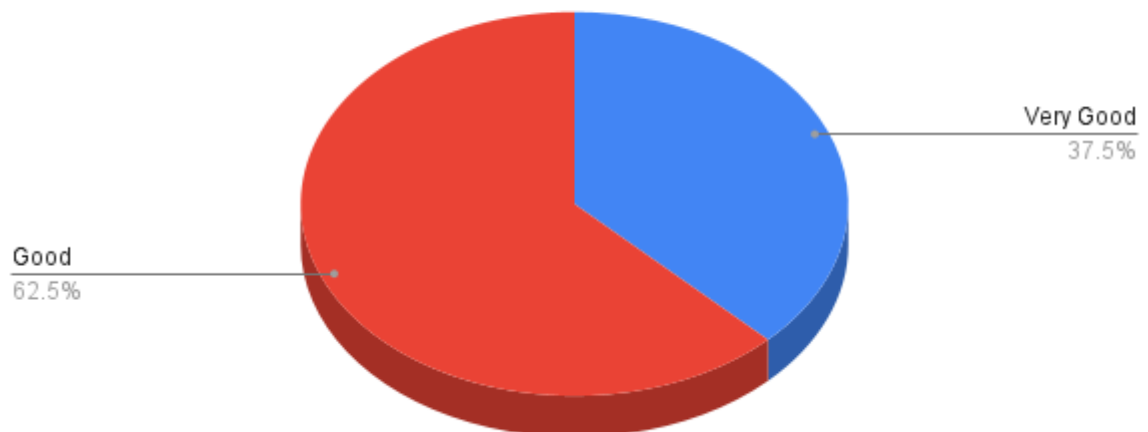




How far the project works/internships offered under your programme were challenging and constructive?

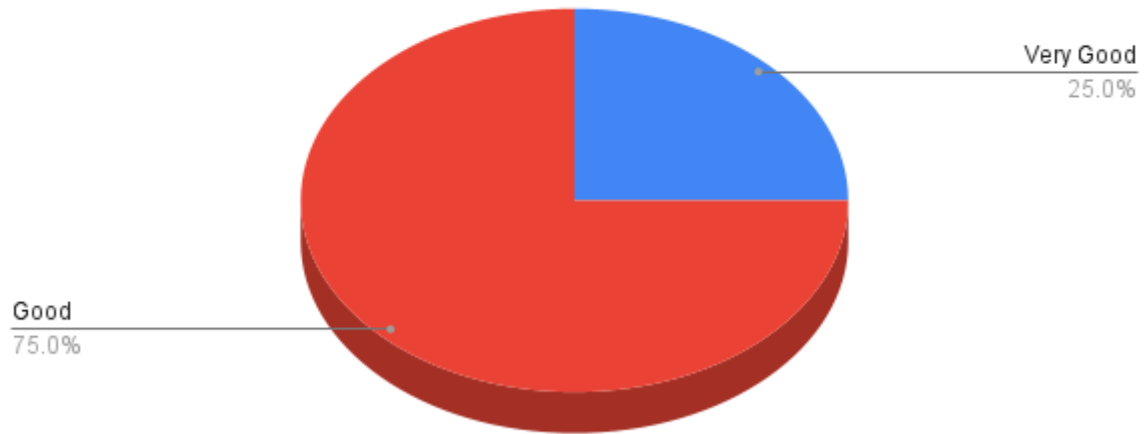


How far did the curriculum create any interest to pursue higher studies or research?

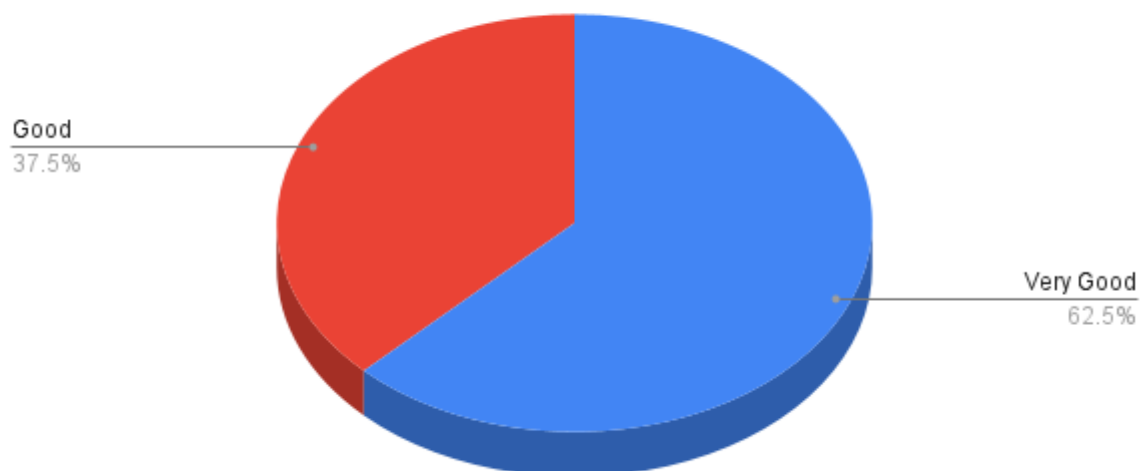




How far did the curriculum bridge gap between industry & academia?

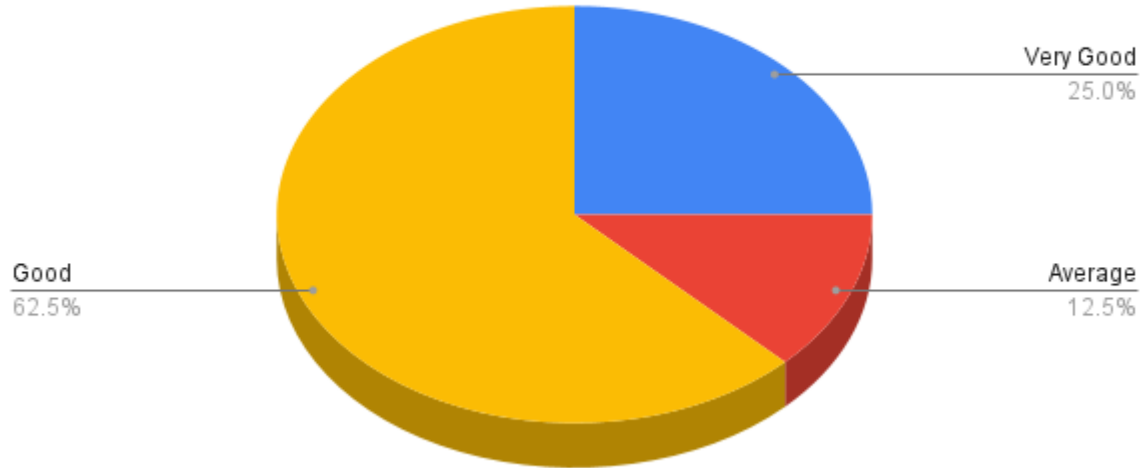


How far do you think the curriculum enhances employability?
